Introduction

The Local Solid Waste Management Enforcement Agency (LEA) for Riverside County is certified by the California Integrated Waste Management Board to enforce state laws and regulations at solid waste facilities within its jurisdiction. The Perris Transfer Station & Material Recovery Facility operates under a Solid Waste Facility Permit issued by the LEA and has filed a Report of Facility Information (RFI), which describes the design and operation of the facility, with the LEA.

Description of the Project

On October 6, 2006, the Governing Board of the South Coast Air Quality Management District (SCAQMD) adopted Rule 410 – Odors from Transfer Stations and Material Recovery Facilities. Rule 410 requires owner or operators of facilities subject to the rule to submit either a SCAQMD – approved Rule 410 Odor Management Plan or a LEA – approved Alternative Odor Management Plan (AOMP) by January 1, 2008. The operator of Moreno Valley Solid Waste Recycling and Transfer Facility has proposed changes to the RFI in order to comply with Rule 410.

LEA's Determination

The operator submitted an application for an RFI amendment to the LEA on December 14, 2007. The LEA reviewed the application and determined that the proposed changes are exempt from the requirements of the California Environmental Quality Act (CEQA), are consistent with State Minimum Standards, and do not conflict with the terms and conditions of the current Solid Waste Facility Permit, pursuant to Section 21665(c) of Title 27 of the California Code of Regulations (27 CCR). The LEA approved the RFI amendments on December 28, 2008.

As required by Section 21660.1 of 27 CCR, the LEA is distributing this notice for the purpose of noticing its acceptance of the amendments to the RFI for the Perris Transfer Station and Material Recovery Facility.
